



Fleet Memo #49: 2019 Core Safety Training Changes

To all Mariners and Technical Crews,

Our old computer based training system offered several topics for general industry and human resources, but did not sufficiently address the very specific hazards we encounter in our offshore operations. Core Safety Training was developed in response to a need for focused training on those issues.

In 2018, our old computer based training (CBT) system was replaced by the MTS SeaDrive units on each of our TDI vessels. In transitioning to the new system, we have reviewed our past training as well as the many new, maritime specific courses offered on SeaDrive. We have also narrowed our focus to topics closely associated with our operations.

There is no longer a separation between Core Safety Training and computer based training. The combined <u>2019 Core Safety Training</u> is now delivered almost entirely by the SeaDrive system, with some training packets remaining for topics not available as a computer based course. As a result, **required training time has been reduced by 2/3rds.** The over 100 other SeaDrive training topics can be used to supplement vessel HSE or presented to the crew as the weekly HSE meeting video.

Unlike in the past, students must be added and courses assigned in the SeaDrive by the Vessel Systems Manager, Shannon Smith. Training Matrices with detailed explanations of the changes will be sent to each vessel so your crew can start the new training courses and catch up on any that are expired or missing.
