Fleet Memo #8: SMM and HSE Manuals now fully electronic

This memo is to advise all personnel that our Safety Management Manual (SMM) and HSE Manuals have now been converted into a FULLY ELECTRONIC format. That means that all paper copies currently on board are OUTDATED and need to be destroyed or disposed of. A Management Review Meeting was held 14 Oct 2010 in which senior management reviewed the SMM and updated several of our procedures and forms. You will soon receive several Notices of Change describing each modification to the SMM .

Many of you prefer to keep a paper copy on board – which is perfectly fine. Just understand that anything printed out will be an UNCONTROLLED copy. That means it will be up to you to update that copy with Notices of Change as they come out.

Opening the Internet Explorer on either the NS5 computer or ship e-mail computer will open to this page or offer you a link to it.
